Capt. Harry, Wilmington Tug's newest Z-Drive "tractor" tug, arrived at the Port of Wilmington, Delaware on her inaugural voyage to her home port on December 21.

Wilmington Tug, Inc. is the largest ship docking tug company on the Delaware River and the only one that is locally-owned, operating out of the Port of Wilmington.

The tug Capt. Harry was named after Captain Harry H. Rowland, Sr., who founded Wilmington Tug in 1965, and had been a river pilot on the Delaware River since 1936.

"Many generations of the Rowland's have worked on the Delaware River since before the Revolutionary War and now Capt. Harry continues this maritime legacy," noted Wilmington Tug President H. Hickman Rowland Jr.

The new tug was designed by naval architect Robert Allan of Vancouver, British Columbia and built by Washburn & Doughty of East Booth Bay, Maine. Due to her twin Detroit Diesel 2,100 hp engines driving a Rolls Royce Z-Drive propulsion system, she has greater escorting capabilities for larger vessels compared with Wilmington Tug's other tractor tugs.

Capt. Harry is 80 ft. long, has a 32 ft. beam and achieves speed up to 12.5 knots. She was designed for handling and docking large crude oil tankers and cargo ships. With an average age of 12 years, Wilmington Tug's fleet of tractor tugs is the newest and most modern on the Delaware River.

Wilmington Tug has grown steadily since the company was established 35 years ago. Today the company docks more than 50% of the ships docking on the Delaware River from Philadelphia to Delaware City, Delaware.
